**ESITI della CONSULTAZIONE DELLE PARTE INTERESSATE ESTERE
intese come SEDI ERASMUS frequentate dagli studenti del CdS, nell’A.A. 2017/18**

Per quanto riguarda le PI a livello internazionale, il CdS in Infermieristica di Modena ha indagato l’ambito di tirocinio all’estero dei propri studenti frequentanti il programma Erasmus Plus, mediante la somministrazione di un questionario, al fine di rilevare il livello di preparazione e le competenze possedute.

Per la realizzazione del questionario è stato preso in considerazione l’elenco delle competenze da sviluppare nell’ambito dei CdS in Infermieristica dei Paesi europei, identificate dal progetto Tuning for Nurses dell’Unione Europea. Il questionario è composto da 22 item, corrispondenti ad altrettante competenze, con quattro opzioni di risposta per ciascuna (*Strongly agree, Agree, Disagree, Strongly disagree*).

È stata condotta una rilevazione nei mesi di giugno e luglio 2018, relativa alle seguenti sedi universitarie:

Sono stati valutati 18 studenti che hanno svolto il Programma Erasmus Plus tra i mesi di gennaio e maggio 2018. Dall’analisi dei questionari compilati emerge che le competenze esaminate sono possedute dagli studenti, in quanto la somma delle risposte *Strongly agree* e *Agree* per tutti i 22 item corrisponde al 100%. In conclusione, a parere dei referenti Erasums+, gli studenti del CdS posseggono la preparazione per un efficace svolgimento del tirocinio clinico all’estero.
